Beef and Noodles

Recipe For the Month I will include two for this month since it is a short newsletter

- 2 lbs of meat (cubed roast beef, or cubed round steak)
- 1pkg of au jus mix (this seems to be a simple seasoning and the right amount other wise
Use beef bouillon)
- 1/2med size onion (chopped)
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 bag of egg noodles

Brown meat in hot skillet, then place meat in crock, mix au jus mix with 3 cups of water or use bouillon. Cook on low while you are at work. Or high if at home watching it. After the beef has become tender, and the egg noodles are cooking do the following.

Pour off all but 1 cup or less of juice (put this in freezer for later use in soups or gravies)
Add mushroom soup to meat and mix. When noodles are tender to your liken add to the crock mix and let sit while you make a small salad. This is a 20-minute meal after along day at work. You can also divide the meat and juice and freeze 1/2for later use. Just don't use too much meat juices with the soup; it will not cling to the noodles.

Peanut Butter Cookie's

2-Cup Peanut Butter

2-Cups Sugar

2- Eggs

Mix the three ingredients (No there is no flour) just these 3 ingredients

Bake at 350 for 8-9 minutes

These are the best Peanut butter Cookies I have ever had. It doesn't make a real big batch but they are soft and rich. I bought these last year at our craft sale at the clubhouse and had to have the recipe.
